

51. SATURDAY NIGHT TRAVELERMac 725 (Saturday Night Special)
(Another dance comes with the record)

- A. GENTS STAR RIGHT across the set, TURN THAT LADY by the LEFT,
STAR BACK HOME and DO-SA-DO, around your own you go,
ALLEMAND LEFT with your CORNERS all, GRAND RIGHT AND LEFT the hall,
ALL THE WAY round you're gonna go until you get back home;
When you meet the girl you know, once again you DO-SA-DO,
Back to back with the pretty little thing, then PROMENADE the ring,
Promenade, go round the world, take a walk with the pretty little girl,
If you're not too late, then SWING your date, swing like Saturday Nite.
- B. HEAD TWO COUPLES go FORWARD and BACK, - - go FORWARD AGAIN,
TURN the OPPOSITE LADY with the RIGHT HAND ROUND, TURN YOUR PARTNER by the
LEFT,
EVERYBODY CORNER by the RIGHT, BACK to your PARTNER with the LEFT,
Go ALL THE WAY AROUND to the RIGHT HAND GIRL and turn her with a RIGHT HAND
ROUND,
PASS YOUR PARTNER BY, and SWING with the CORNER girl,
Swing that corner girl around and PROMENADE the town,
Promenade, go round the world, take a walk with the pretty little girl,
If you're not too late, then SWING your date, swing like Saturday Nite.

Routine: There are only six choruses of music. Do figure (B) twice with
heads and twice with sides, using the two breaks as desired.

52. FOLLOW THE LEADER

Any good reel or hornpipe

- A. ALL FOUR LADIES GRAND CHAIN, and then whirlaway,
HALF SASHAY, then TWO AND FOUR, FORWARD & BACK that way,
HEAD TWO COUPLES RIGHT & LEFT THRU, turn her, make a ring,
CIRCLE LEFT, here we go, 'round like everything,
FIRST GENT, TURN-RIGHT-BACK, FOLLOW THE LEADER on the OUTSIDE track,
Round you go in SINGLE FILE, keep on going 'about ninety miles,
The GIRLS STAR RIGHT, PASS YOUR JOE, NEXT TIME ROUND, DO PAS O,
Etc. (Promenade the corner home)

Routine: Repeat for 3rd gent, then 2nd gent, then 4th gent, using breaks
as desired.

53. INDIAN STYLE

Fol-1151

- A. FIRST CPL BOW and SWING, then chase that pretty girl round the ring,
NOW CHASE um rabbit, chase um squirrel, chase um pretty gal round the world,
CHASE um baboon, chase um coon, chase um old man round the moon,
SWING your squaw high and low, square um set and away we go;
SQUAWS in the CENTER, HANDS UP HIGH, build um tepee, don't be shy,
CHIEFS DUCK UNDER on heel and toe, hurry up, Indian, away you go,
In and out, out and under, MEET UM SQUAW, SWING like thunder,
ALLEMAND LEFT with your left hand, RIGHT to your squaw, RIGHT & LEFT GRAND,
Etc.

(Instead of touching hands in the grand right and left, hold up hand
and say HOW to each one you meet; when you meet your partner, give out
with a loud UGH and then promenade home.)

Routine: A for each cpl.
