

"BUILD A BRIDGE"

This figure is executed from promenade in Grand Circle. The promenade is simply a march of couples in circle, counterclockwise, the gent on the inside of the circle with his partner on his right.

As soon as the figure is called, the leading couple reverse their direction, separating at the same instant and the gent holding his partner's right hand with his left, raise their hands to form an arch over the heads of the other couples as they continue to dance counterclockwise. Each couple behind the leading couple follows suit. As soon as the leading couple has reached the rear of the column of dancers, they fall into promenade and follow the couple in front, the couple behind continuing to follow them until all are promenading again (see Fig. 22 below).

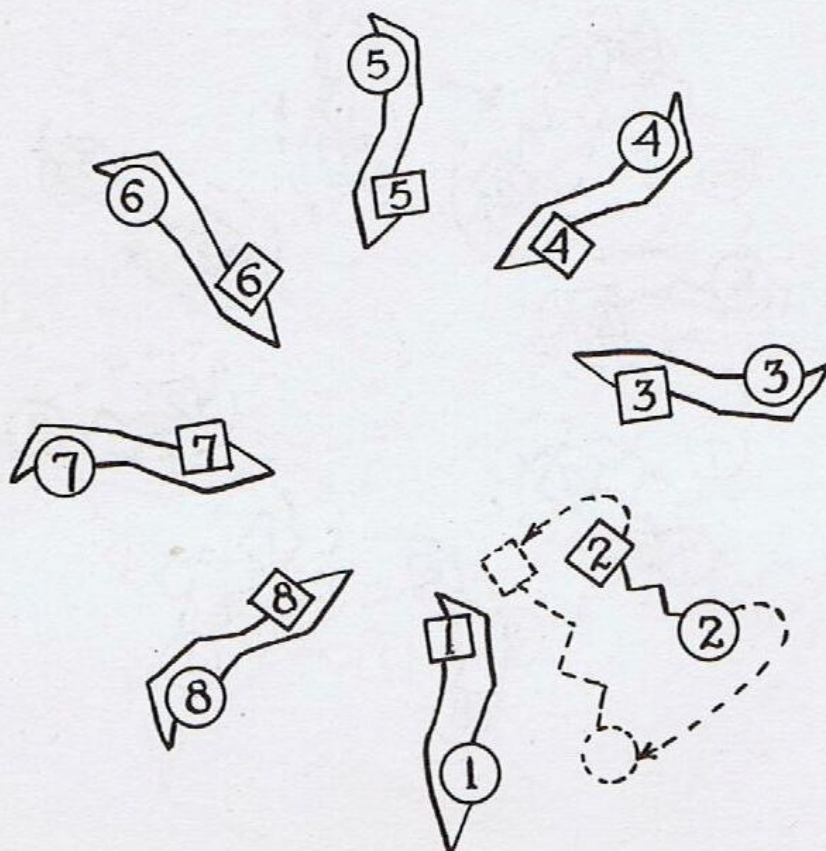
